Business Incubation Center of NUML (B ICON) and Global Center for Innovators (CGI) signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) on March 15, 2018 to establish "Pakistan Innovation Hub" at NUML.

Innovation hub will be jointly managed by B ICON and CGI.





CGI will provide consultancy to build, operate and run the hub; it will design and deliver curriculum for Accelerator Programs. CGI will provide access to global network of mentors/advisors for social entrepreneurship programs.

Training of Regional Directors on 'Governance of University and Campuses'

ORIC organized a training program, "Training of Regional Directors on Governance of University and its Campuses" on January 17-18, 2018.

Objectives of workshop were, to provide strategic vision and direction to Regional Directors for enhancing overall governance of their respective campuses, to inform them of newly introduced policies and procedures as well as strategic developments taking place at National University of Modern Languages (NUML) in near future, to refresh information regarding current policies and Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) to be implemented in the regional campuses and to



benchmark best practices and set targets for each campus. Session on "State of the Futures"

A session on "State of the Futures" was organized by ORIC on March 13, 2018 at Confucius Seminar Hall of Ibn-e-Khaldun Block.

Prof. Dr. Jerome C. Glenn was invited as guest speaker. He is co-founder and CEO of The Millennium Project (on global futures research) and lead author with Elizabeth Florescu, and The Millennium Project Team of the 'State of the Future' reports of the Millennium Project for the past twenty years.

Dr. Glenn started with a presentation on Introduction to Millennium Project. Project was founded in 1996 after a three-year feasibility study with the United Nations University (UNU), Smithsonian Institution, Futures Group International, and the American Council for the UNU.



It is now an independent non-profit global participatory futures research think tank of futurists, scholars, business planners, and policy makers who work for international organizations, governments, corporations, NGOs, and universities.

The Millennium Project manages a coherent and cumulative process that collects and assesses judgments from over 2,500 people since the beginning of the project selected by its 40 Nodes around the world. The work is distilled in its annual "State of the Future", "Futures Research Methodology" series, and special studies.

The project is not a one-time study of the future, but provides an on-going capacity as a geographically and institutionally dispersed think tank.

The State of the Future is an extraordinarily rich distillation of information for those who care about the world and its future. It describes in non-technical language what the educated person should know about the world and what to do to improve it.

While addressing the students, he emphasized on looking into the field of Future. He briefed them

about the Future by stating, we cannot look into human nature without looking at the future. He suggested all countries should have committees on Future.

Although the future has been getting better for most of the world over the past 20 years, the global recession has lowered the State of the Future Index for the next 10 years. The



global financial crisis and climate change planning may be helping humanity to re-think its assumptions and move from its often self-centered adolescence to a more globally responsible adulthood.

Afterwards, Commodore (Retd.) Muhammad Azhar (Community Lead - AGAHI) briefed about a report, 'Pakistan State of Future Index (Pk-SOFI)' by Foresight Lab. Pk-SOFI is a 10-year future index composed of 30 variables that indicates if the future is getting better or worse.

The Index was developed by the Millennium Project as an effort to measure the changing state of the future.

Lab in collaboration with its partnering organizations, which include



ORIC-NUML and individuals, came together for the compilation of the 2017 inaugural report.

Session was attended by Brig. Muhammad Ibrahim (Director General, NUML), Prof. Dr. Karamat Ali (Director ORIC), Brig. (Retd.) Dr. Maqsud-ul-Hassan (Dean Faculty Management Sciences), faculty members and students of Management Sciences. At the end, Director ORIC presented shield to Prof. Dr. Jerome C. Glenn.



Information Session on Hult Prize Competition
